**Annual Report for DIR 021/2002, for the year 26 July 2010
to 25 July 2011**

I refer to the requirements of the above licence (viz. general conditions 16 to 19), to provide the OGTR with an annual report within 90 days of the anniversary of the issue date of this licence.

During the period 26 July 2010 to 25 July 2011, no intentional commercial activities were undertaken with InVigor® Hybrid canola in Australia. A total of 6 research and innovation trials were conducted during the 2010-11 summer in Victoria, and 16 trials were conducted in South Australia under a State Exemption Order. For the 2011 winter, 6 trials are being conducted in Victoria and 3 trials are being conducted in NSW.

The trial areas planted in each state were as follows:

Vic Summer - 14 ha (6 sites)
SA Summer - 40 ha (16 sites)
Vic Winter - 60 ha (6 sites)
NSW Winter - 8 ha (3 sites)

Note that these trial areas do not include plantings of InVigor® Hybrid canola under licence DIR 069/2006.

During this reporting period, no adverse effects of InVigor® Hybrid canola were observed at any of the DIR 021/2002 trial sites. Furthermore, no unexpected adverse effects were reported to us as a result of dealings licensed by DIR 021/2002.
