

## Quarterly activities report for April – June 2017

The quarterly activities include details of monitoring and compliance activities by the Office of the Gene Technology Regulator (OGTR) during the quarter.

### Monitoring of GMO Dealings involving Intentional Release (DIR)

During the quarter OGTR inspected **10 GM plant field trial sites** (Table 1). The inspections comprised:

**Current field trial sites:** Of the **19** sites current in the quarter, **three** were inspected. This represents a monitoring rate of **16 per cent** of all current sites for the quarter.

**Post-harvest field trial sites:** Of the **71** sites subject to post-harvest monitoring in the quarter, **seven** were inspected. This represents an inspection rate of **10 per cent** of all sites subject to post-harvest monitoring in this quarter.
