# Quarterly activities report for July - September 2024

The quarterly activities include details of monitoring and compliance activities by the Office of the Gene Technology Regulator (OGTR) during the quarter.

#### Monitoring of GMO Dealings involving Intentional Release (DIR)

During the quarter OGTR inspected **13 GM plant field trial sites** (**Table 1**). The inspections comprised:

- Current field trial sites of the **eight** sites current in the quarter, **four** were inspected.
- Post-harvest field trial sites of the **23** sites subject to post-harvest monitoring in the quarter, **nine** were inspected.

During the July – September 2024 quarter the OGTR continued an audit of Monash University in Victoria.

The 10<sup>th</sup> National Institutional Biosafety Committee (IBC) Forum was held in Canberra from 16 to 18 September 2024. The forum encourages IBC representatives from Accredited

Organisations to engage with each other and the OGTR on topics relevant to the regulation of genetically modified organisms in Australia.
